### To Burn or Not to Burn?

There are several ways to get rid of the leaves after they have fallen. One way is to burn them. But, before you fire them up there are restrictions. Technically since Stone Ridge is within one mile of the city limits (according to the Clearcreek Fire department) we are not permitted to burn leaves. The only exception is if the purpose of the fire is to cook food and if prior notice is given to the Clearcreek Fire dept. at 748-2766. You must call during regular weekday hours.

### Sign Reminder

As we begin the campaign journey, we remind homeowners that political signs are not permitted per the covenants.



During daylight saving time, clocks are turned forward an hour, effectively moving an hour of daylight from the morning to the evening. At 2:00 a.m., on November 4, 2007 we will revert back to regular time. Therefore, clocks will be turned BACK one hour.
